TRANSPORTATION

Transport arrangements:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Participants are expected to arrange their own transportation between Dubrovnik Airport (DBV), their hotel and the meeting venue. • Transportation from the seminar venue to the dinner venue will be provided by ESASI. • Dubrovnik Airport is located about 20–25 minutes' drive from the city; Platanus airport buses (EUR 10 (one-way) / EUR 15 (return)) taxis (approx. EUR 45) and ride-hailing services are available.
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ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Entry visa and passport requirements:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Croatia is part of the Schengen Area; Schengen rules apply. Participants should check visa requirements well in advance with the nearest Croatian embassy or consulate or official government website. • Passports should generally be valid for at least 3 months beyond the intended stay, with sufficient blank pages. • Participants requiring a visa are strongly encouraged to apply at least one month before the start of the seminar to avoid delays and inconveniences
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LOCAL INFORMATION

Health:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • It is strongly recommended that participants have travel and health insurance valid in Croatia for the full duration of their stay. • The public health system is well developed; European participants should carry their European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) where applicable, as well as proof of any private insurance. • Tap water in Dubrovnik is safe to drink. • Pharmacies (“<i>ljekarna</i>”) are widely available.
Weather:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In May, Dubrovnik typically experiences mild to warm Mediterranean weather, with daytime temperatures usually between 18°C and 24°C and cooler evenings. • Light clothing with an extra layer for the evening, a light rain jacket, comfortable walking shoes and sun protection are recommended.
Local currency:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The official currency of Croatia is the euro (€). • Credit and debit cards are widely accepted in hotels, restaurants and shops; ATMs are available throughout the city.
Electricity:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Standard voltage in Croatia is 230V at a frequency of 50Hz. • Power outlets are Type C and Type F (two round pins); most European devices are compatible.
