Trains runs every 30 minutes and take approximately 25 minutes. You will require a ticket for 2 zones (core zone 100 & 280) EUR4.80.

Approximately 16 minutes from the Airport to the city centre. EUR14.90 (single) EUR24.90 (return).

#### Taxi

A taxi from the airport to the centre of Vienna takes 20 minutes (depending on traffic) and costs approximately EUR40 (each direction).

The meeting is hosted by the Austrian Safety Investigation Authority. The venue is modern. Refreshments will be provided on-site; however participants will be expected to source and purchase their own lunch off-site nearby. The venue will have dedicated IT support and Wi-Fi access.

Smoking: Smoking is prohibited inside the building. There are designated smoking areas outside, please ask at the venue for details.

#### **GENERAL:**

Vienna, Austria's capital, spans both sides of the beautiful Danube. It is often referred to as the city of music due to its classical musical legacy and was also home to the world's first psychoanalyst. It is rich in architectural culture including baroque palaces, monuments, museums and parks. It is also home to the Wiener Riesenrad, one of the earliest Ferris wheels ever built.

The location for the ESASI 2025 seminar will be the Federal Ministry for Climate Action, Environment, Energy, Mobility, Innovation and Technology (BMK), accessible from the three suggested hotels via the subway station Wien Mitte/Landstrasse (takes approx. 15 minutes).

English and Austrian are the most frequently used languages.

Climate: In Vienna the average daytime temperature in May is around 20°C with the evenings being cooler. There may also be some rainfall.

**Currency**: The currency in Vienna is the EURO.

**<u>Electricity supply</u>**: Electric voltage is 230V. European standard plugs and electric connectors are used.
